Mr. Abramovitz is a native of Norristown, Pennsylvania. He is a graduate of Drexel University, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, with a B.S. in Civil Engineering.

In 1950, Mr. Abramovitz was hired by the city of Dayton to head the comprehensive study of its sanitary and storm sewer systems. He spent five years with the city's Bureau of Sewers where he served as Chief Engineer. Mr. Ralph Woolpert asked Mr. Abramovitz to join his engineering firm in 1955. Mr. Abramovitz was in charge of planning and engineering for the proposed Huber Heights subdivision. In 1960, Mr. Abramovitz became a partner in Mr. Woolpert's firm, and was named Managing Partner of Woolpert Consultants. Under Mr. Abramovitz's management, Woolpert Consultants expanded from a local firm to a national firm with offices throughout the United States.

Mr. Abramovitz has been very active in professional and community organizations. He is a fellow of the Engineers Club of Dayton and the American Society of Civil Engineers; a member of the National Society of Professional Engineers, the Urban Land Institute, American Public Works Association, American Water Works Association, American Society for Engineering Education and American Planning Association. He was also President of The United Way from 1973 - 1974, and has remained active with the organization for many years. In 1983, Mr. Abramovitz took over as President of the Jewish Federation of Dayton.

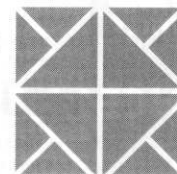
