

Chuck Buchanan Honored

Receives Awards in Paris, Detroit

Board of Governor's Member Chuck Buchanan was feted at a Banquet at Meadowbrook Estate, the Dodge mansion in Detroit, for his accomplishments involving seven patented inventions over the past 18 months. All of the inventions involved mechanisms, systems and actuators for power sliding doors for Valeo, the French company which purchased ITT Automotive of Kettering, Ohio. Mr. Buchanan was awarded the position as a Valeo Senior Expert of Engineering, second only to one or two Master Experts in the entire company. He also won the Prix de L'innovations Valeo Award for one of the six Top Profitable Inventions in the Company in 1999, conferred during another Presentation in Paris in April, 1999. The seven inventions are the most recent of Buchanan's 40+ inventions during his career involving suspension systems, actuator systems and wiper systems used on automotive accessories.
