The highlight of the 1993 Founder's Night will be the induction of Ervin J. Nutter as Fellow of the Engineers Club of Dayton. In bestowing its highest honor, the Engineers Club recognizes the outstanding contributions Ervin has made.

Engineers Club Member Since 1970

Ervin J. Nutter was born on June 26, 1914 in Hamilton, Ohio. He graduated from Hamilton High School and attended the University of Kentucky, where he received a Bachelor's Degree in Mechanical Engineering in 1943.

Nutter paid for his college education by working as an electrician in the University's Maintenance Department. His distinguished business career was launched when he accepted a position as a civilian engineer in the Wright-Patterson Air Force Equipment Laboratory as the only civilian Branch Chief. He was responsible for testing of Air Force aircraft and equipment in adverse environmental conditions for worldwide operations.

In 1950, with only a \$360 investment, the entrepreneur started an engineering and manufacturing company that grew from one employee to one of the world's leading manufacturers of sophisticated tubular assemblies for private, commercial, and military jet engines.

Today, Mr. Nutter is known for his expertise and success in a variety of business interests including: Founder and past CEO of the Elano Corporation, Acme Screw Products, Enlo Incorporated, and Elano East Corporation (General Electric purchased Elano and its affiliates from Mr. Nutter in December 1985). He continues to operate KBJ Ranch in Beavercreek.

He is a Registered Professional Engineer in the states of Ohio and Kentucky and holds a license as an instrument rated commercial multi-engine aircraft pilot.

He has received numerous honors over the years for his leadership and participation in the areas of:

Academics: Honorary Doctor of Laws Degree, Engineer of the Year (twice), Tau Beta Pi Engineering Honorary, past president of the National Alumni Association and Development Council, and past chairman of the Fellows' Club at the University of Kentucky. He also holds membership in the President's Club at the University of Kentucky, Ohio State University, University of Dayton, and Wright State University; Phi Delta Kappa; Gamma Sigma Delta; Former Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Wright State University; Board Member of the Air Force Institute of Technology.

Civic and Professional: Air Force Museum Board of Managers and Foundation; Society Bank N.A. Advisory Board; Past President National Aviation Hall of Fame; Defense Orientation Conference Association; U.S. Air Force Exceptional Service Award; the Mason's Grand Master's Community Service Award; E. G. Shaw Outstanding Service Award from the Beavercreek Chamber of Commerce; Ohio State University's OARDC Agricultural Service Award; selected for Greene County Man of the Year Award in 1981.

Mr. Nutter resides in Beavercreek, Ohio with his wife Zoe Dell, and is the father of three sons: Kenneth, Joseph and Robert.
